

JUDGING SCHEDULE OF 4-H PROJECTS

- For projects brought in at early check-in time, written judge's comments and ribbons may be picked up at project release.
- 2. During 4-H open judging, the judge will critique each project and award a blue, red, white or green ribbon as he/she deems worthy using the rules published in the current Morgan County 4-H Handbook or Indiana State Fair book.
- 3. During Mini 4-H open judging, the judge will examine each project and give a multi-colored 4-H Mini ribbon.
- 4. For display at the Fair, each regular 4-H project will have a sticker, or stickers, placed on the name label that will indicate its placing. Actual ribbons will <u>not</u> be placed on individual projects due to the risk of theft or damage.
- 5. Special placings, Special Merit, Reserve Champion, Champion, and State Fair ribbons, will be handed out during project check-out and premium time. Each 4-H member will only receive the highest ranking ribbon of these special placings.
- 6. ALL 4-H EXHIBITS RECEIVED AFTER JUDGING HAS BEEN COMPLETED WILL RECEIVE A PARTICIPATION (GREEN) RIBBON ONLY!
- 7. The 4-H and Community Building is <u>closed to all Non-Workers</u> until the 4-H Open House. Any 4-H members, parents, or general public are **prohibited** from entering the building until the Open House. **This is a safety issue and will be strictly enforced!**
