

CAMPGROUND RULES AND AGREEMENT

1. Camping is permitted between April 1 and October 31. No individual or recreational vehicles shall be allowed in the campground more than 21 days per calendar year.
2. Those desiring to use the campground must check in with the groundskeeper at his home on the grounds or at the fair office and **pay prior to camping.**
3. **The fee for camping will be \$20.00 per day** except during the fair. **Only Fair Board members, 4-H parents, and Merchant exhibitors may reserve camping space for fair week.**
4. In regards to specific camping groups using the grounds; if special electrical hook-ups are needed, they shall be assessed the cost of providing them. They shall, also, pay the same fee as others to camp. No special rates will be used.
5. There must be at least 3 recreational vehicles in the campgrounds for the rest rooms to be opened.
6. During the Morgan County Fair, the campgrounds shall be open to only those involved in the Fair. **Fair week campers will be charged a special camping fee of \$150.00 for the nine days of the fair.** It is asked that campers for fair week, come in on Thursday, the day before the Fair actually begins.
7. You may make your reservations any time after January 1st by sending your check and this contract to the Fair office at P. O. Box 1534, Martinsville, IN 46151. Fair week camping must be paid at the time reservations are made. As camping space is assigned on a first come basis, it is advisable to reserve and pay for your space early.
8. **Persons under the age of 18 staying in the camping area of the Morgan County fairgrounds must be directly supervised by a parent or legal guardian between the hours of midnight and 6:00 am. If it is found that a parent or legal guardian is not present in the camping area during this time, the parent will be called and asked to pick up their children immediately. Quiet time is between one-half hour after the carnival closes until 6:00 am.**
9. Only one vehicle per camper will be allowed to park in the campground area. You are paying for a space for your camper, not a parking space. Other vehicles are to park in the Horseshoe Court parking lot.
10. All pets must be kept inside the campers and not allowed to run loose outside the camper.
11. All water hoses from campers must be able to be completely shut off. No leaking hoses will be allowed.
12. All camper/recreational vehicles must be out of the campgrounds by Sunday noon after the fair closes on Saturday night, or pay the regular camping fee. All power to the camping area will be shut down at noon on Sunday.
13. The Morgan County Fair & 4-H Club Association, Inc. is not responsible for any damage done to campers or contents by any act of nature or power not under their control.
14. These rules became effective as of 2/10/98 and were amended 9/10/02. These rules were further amended 2/14/06, 2/20/07, 2/12/08, 3/9/09, 3/4/11 and 7/29/12.
