

OPEN CLASS SHEEP

JUDGING - SATURDAY, August 1, 2020 - 5:00 P.M.

1. The following classes will be provided: Columbia, Commercial (sections 6, 7, 8 and 9 only), Suffolk, Corriedale, Oxford, Montadale, Dorset, Southdown, Shropshire, Cheviot, Hampshire, and Shetland.
2. Arrival time and registration for Open Class Sheep is Saturday, August 1 from 9:00 am until 12:00 noon. Pre registration is not required.
3. An entry fee will be payable with entry form: Breeding sheep - \$3.00 Morgan County entries and \$5.00-out of county entries; Market Lambs - \$5.00 Morgan County entries and \$10.00-out of county entries. Ewe lambs shown in breeding classes are not eligible to show in Section 15 - Market Lambs.
4. Market lambs will be weighed at 1:00 p.m. and then divided into the four weight classes.
5. Morgan County 4-H exhibitors showing in the Open Class Sheep show must check in sheep Saturday, August 1, during the posted arrival times for Open Class Sheep. 4-H members showing market lambs may use their official 4-H weight. The weight must be turned in when the lamb is entered or will have to be re-weighed at 1:00 the same as other open entries.
6. During the show, aisles MUST be free of trimming stands to allow movement to show ring.
7. Unless noted otherwise, all breeding stock will be shown according to the Indiana State air Open Class rules for that particular breed. Decisions of the show Judge and/or the Superintendent are final.
8. If there are not three or more exhibits, and two or more exhibitors in a class, a first place ribbon and second place money will be awarded.
9. Open showmanship classes will be offered in a jackpot format. There will be four classes: Class 1 is for anyone up to second grade. Class 2 is for grades 3 through 5. Class 3 is for grades 6 through 8, and Class 4 is for grade 9 up to anyone who is less than 21 years old as of the date of the show. Entry fee is \$5 per participant. Premium will depend on the number of entrants, with 100% of the entry fees per class awarded to the class winner. Entries must be made before noon on show day. Showmanship classes will take place between the Market Lamb show and the Breeding Stock show.
