GENERAL LIVESTOCK RULES

Even though the State Board of Animal Health is not requiring Certificates of Veterinary Inspection for animals that originate in Indiana, the Morgan County Fair has ruled that all animals will be inspected before unloading. If there is any question about the health of an animal, a veterinarian may be consulted. Animals that originate outside the State of Indiana must have a properly completed official certificate of veterinary inspection.

Indiana state law requires premise identification for all locations associated with the purchase, sale or exhibition of livestock in the state. Please be prepared to supply your premise ID number when entering your livestock for the fair. If you have any questions, call BOAH toll free at 1-877-747-3038 or email at ghaynes@boah.in.gov.

Please pay particular attention to the deadlines for entry on the following pages for your animal to be exhibited. Some superintendents require pre-entry.
